Ensure that the after-business-hours emergency process is clear and communicated, and escalate issues to the Regional Operations Manager or Safety and Risk Manager when necessary.
- Collaboration with Booking Operations Manager: Work in partnership with the Booking Operations Manager based in Ho Chi Minh City to ensure that quotes, reservations, and program experiences align seamlessly and lead to exceptional onthe-ground execution.
- **Program Development:** Collaborate with the Product Development Manager to ensure that program design is authentic, meaningful, culturally appropriate, and rooted in the company's mission.
- Adventure Leader Management: Work in partnership with the Adventure Leader Manager and Regional Managers to ensure that Adventure Leader training and staffing are aligned with the vision for student learning, the overall program goals for our educational tours, and the best possible customer experience for our adventure tours.
